Practice: There will be two ends of two minutes practice before each session.

Shooting: Four archers per boss in two details of two. Arrows will be shot in ends of 3 in two minutes on vertical three spot faces controlled by lights.

Drug Testing: Record status tournaments are liable for drug testing and any competitors approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Where an entry form contains one or more junior entries, the parent or legal guardian must countersign the form to signify they consent to their child(ren) being tested.

Dress: GNAS dress regulations (Rule 307) apply and will be enforced.
